



Dear Residents of Mission Ridge HOA:

Please be advised that, weather permitting, the asphalt pavement in your association will be sealcoated on:

Thursday, 3/29/12 – Sealcoat asphalt pavement

-LOGISTICS-

Please remove all vehicles from the asphalt pavement by 7:00 a.m. on the above-mentioned date. Access to the work area will be denied to all vehicles. You will need to look for available street parking. In advance, no parking signs will be posted. Please do not return until the barricades are removed; plan on remaining off of the pavement for up to 24 - 36 hours.

Close windows and doors during the cleaning process. It can be very dusty. Turn off outside water at least 24 hours prior to the sealcoat procedures and do not allow water to get onto the newly sealed pavement for at least 48 hours after the sealcoat has dried. When walking, carefully use the cement gutters, walkways, or grass. Please do not step on the wet sealcoat; it has a dark shiny color and is very messy. Please keep children and pets off of the fresh surface.

Any vehicle left on a section of asphalt pavement scheduled for repairs will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.
